

- \_\_2. WORKSHOP: Tyler Technologies demonstration of ERP Pro Financial Management Application software.**

**Kirk Cunningham, Senior Account Executive and Aaron Royal, Solutions Consultant, were present to conduct the workshop. Mr. Cunningham stated that ninety counties are currently using the ERP Pro Financial Management Application software. After a brief slide presentation on Tyler Technologies, Mr. Royal began the workshop. The workshop consisted of a visual presentation of the software and its capabilities. There was an extensive conversation on the ways to capture employees time and how to handle invoices with this software. Commissioner Gertson excused himself and left the meeting at 10:50 A.M. The Commissioners discussed making sure that all elected officials that will be utilizing this software are onboard with using Tyler Technologies. Joyce Guthman, County Treasurer, spoke on the reasons why she preferred this software. Judge Prause asked for clarification on some of the controversies with Tyler's other products. He wanted to be sure that the County data will be safe and not breached. Judge Prause also questioned the support the County would receive from Tyler Technologies. Judge Prause suggested to add Tyler Technologies to the next Commissioner Court meeting agenda on November 14 and invite department heads to come and give their opinions on the software. The last topic covered was the \$56,000 annual fee. This fee covers all support, hardware, security, back up, software, and all the upgrades and enhancements. This price will not change for the first three years.**


