



PROCLAMATION AND ORDER OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF EAGLE LAKE, TEXAS, ORDERING ELECTION TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE MUNICIPALITY WILL ADOPT THE CITY MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT.

Whereas, Chapter 25 of the Texas Local Government Code provides for the adoption of the city manager form of government by a general-law municipality; and

Whereas, the clerk of the City of Eagle Lake, a general-law municipality, has received a petition requesting the mayor to call a special election to determine whether the city shall adopt the city-manager form of government; and

Whereas, the clerk of the City and the County Elections Administrator have determined that the petition is signed by more than 47 qualified voters, a number of qualified voters of the City greater than 20 percent of the persons who voted for the mayor at the most recent municipal election at which the office of mayor was to be filled; and

Now, therefore,

1. A special election is hereby ordered to be held on November 3, 2020, the next uniform election date, for the purpose of determining whether the City of Eagle Lake will adopt the city manager form of government.
2. A copy of this proclamation must be posted in at least five conspicuous places in the city for at least 10 days preceding election day.
3. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted in accordance with a subsequent order of special election.

This proclamation is issued this the 7th day of July, 2020.
