Good morning, Judge Prause.

I have just received word from the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) about the ending of the Public Health Emergency (PHE) and Major Disaster Declaration (MDD). Effective immediately the WCJC Senior Citizens Program can no longer deliver meals for congregate consumers to be consumed at home. All congregate meals must be consumed at the senior center.

This means that all of the congregate members in Columbus that have been receiving meals at their home while we've been waiting for a new senior center site location to open, must now cease receiving those meals. Those congregate members will not be able to receive any more meals from our program until we have an open senior center for them in Columbus. Fortunately, this will not affect the senior citizens in the program who are homebound (a.k.a. Meals on Wheels). Homebound seniors in Columbus will continue receiving their meals at their homes as normal.

I am so sorry to be the bearer of bad news. When you are able to find a new location for us to set up our senior center program there in Columbus, please let me know and we will get things up and running as soon as possible. This has come as a shock to us all. Our congregate members in Columbus do not know yet. I will be mailing out letters and making phone calls to inform them all of this new policy.







Dear Sheriff Wied:

SHP's Health Services Agreement with Colorado County will soon be due to rollover for a new 12-month period, and we look forward to continuing in service as the on-site provider of inmate medical care. Please feel free, at any time, to reach out to me with any questions or needs related to the contract.

Being on the front lines caring for patients and serving our customers' correctional health care needs, SHP has repeatedly confronted a range of financial and operational challenges since the outset of the pandemic, including substantial growth in expenses across labor, drugs and supplies, let alone higher economy-wide inflation. Labor costs have presented a dramatic and extended wave of challenges. Quality staffing is central to the care process and represents a significant portion of our operating budget. With nursing shortages being what they are nationally, we have continued to experience considerable issues with recruitment and retention of nurses, especially in perspective to correctional work.

As we strive to ensure coverage at our facilities, we have become increasingly reliant on utilizing current staff, Operational managers, travel nurses and agency staffing as resources for providing coverage until we can bring on permanent team members to fill open positions. We have increased recruitment efforts as well as added higher pay rate scales, sign-on on bonuses, and other benefits to help attract applicants. These coverage and recruitment practices, of course, come at a much greater cost to SHP than originally budgeted for in our contracts, as the parties could not have foreseen such an unprecedented hike in healthcare labor costs.

Professional lines insurance and employee benefits costs have continued on an upward trend, as well as expenses for prescription drugs. A significant driver in increased medication costs has been the continued spike in drug prices, coupled with increased utilization, treating sicker patients in the correctional environment during and since the pandemic. Medical supply costs are another area which has hit hard over the past few years, in light of supply chain disruptions and infection control practices/procedures put in place to comply with governmental regulations and to assure the health and safety of patients, and facility/medical staff.

Despite persistent cost pressures, SHP has tried to price for annual contract adjustments modestly in recent years. Unfortunately, our direct and indirect costs have escalated to the point of being unsustainable without an adequate annual increase for the new contract year. We have incorporated an additional \$409.51 per month on the base contract fee, as well as a slight increase on the per diem rate, based on continuation of the program at the current level of staffing/services for the 2024 period. The new rates are provided for you below.

Per diem greater than 80 inmates:	\$1.52



BYLAWS OF COLORADO COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

POWERS AND PURPOSES

Section 1. Financing of Industrial Development Projects. In order to implement the purposes for which the Colorado County Industrial Development Corporation (the "Corporation") was formed as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall issue obligations to finance all or part of the cost of one or projects as defined in the Development Corporation Act of 1979, Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes, as amended (the "Act").

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Conditions Precedent to Issuance of</u> <u>Obligations</u>. The Corporation shall not issue any obligations unless:

(1) The Commissioners Court (the "Governing Body") of Colorado County (the "County") has approved by resolution, adopted no more than 60 days prior to the date of delivery of the obligations, any resolution of the Corporation providing for the issuance of the obligations; and

(2) The Texas Industrial Commission, or the executive director thereof, has approved the contents of any lease, sale or loan agreement made by the Corporation under the Act in connection with the issuance of obligations by affirmatively finding that the project sought to be financed is in furtherance of the public purposes of the Act.

Section 3. Books and Records; Approval of Programs and Financial Statements. The Corporation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the proceedings of its Board of Directors (the "Board of Directors") and committees having any of the authority of the Board of Directors. All books and records of the Corporation may be inspected by any director or his agent or attorney for any proper purpose at any reasonable time; and at all times the Governing Body will have access to the books and records of the Corporation. The County shall be entitled to approve all programs and expenditures

of the Corporation and annually review any financial statements of the Corporation.

Section 4. Nonprofit Corporation. The Corporation shall be a nonprofit corporation. No dividends shall ever be paid by the Corporation and no part of its net earnings remaining after payment of its expenses shall inure to the benefit of any of its directors or officers of any individual, firm or corporation, except that in the event the Board of Directors shall determine that sufficient provision has been made for the full payment of the expenses, bonds and other obligations of the Corporation issued to finance all or part of the cost of a project, then any net earnings of the Corporation thereafter accruing with respect to said project shall be paid to the County.

ARTICLE II

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. Powers, Number and Term of Office. The property and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed and controlled by the Board of Directors and, subject to the restrictions imposed by law, the Articles of Incorporation and these Bylaws, the Board of Directors shall exercise all of the powers of the Corporation.

The Board of Directors shall consist of $\underline{N_{NE}}$ (9) directors, each of whom shall be appointed by the Governing Body.

The directors constituting the first Board of Directors shall be those directors named in the Articles of Incorporation, each of whom shall serve for a term established in the Articles of Incorporation or until his or her successor is appointed as hereinafter provided. Subsequent directors shall hold office for a term established by the Governing Body or until their successors are appointed by the Governing Body.

Any director may be removed from office, by the Governing Body, for cause or at will.

Section 2. Meetings of Directors. The directors may hold their meetings at such place or places in the State of Texas, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine; provided, however, in the absence of any such determination by the Board of Directors, the meetings shall be held at the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Texas.

Section 3. <u>Regular Meetings</u>. Regular Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held without the necessity of notice at such times and places as shall be designated, from time to time, by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Special Meetings. Special Meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held whenever called by the president, by the secretary, by a majority of the directors for the time being in office or upon advice or request by the Governing Body.

The secretary shall give notice to each director of each Special Meeting in person, or by mail, telephone or telegraph, at least two (2) hours before the meeting. Unless otherwise indicated in the notice thereof, any and all matters pertaining to the purposes of the Corporation may be considered and acted upon at a Special Meeting. At any meeting at which every director shall be present, even though without any notice, any matter pertaining to the purpose of the Corporation may be considered and acted upon.

Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the directors fixed by the Articles of Incorporation shall constitute a quorum for the consideration of matters pertaining to the purposes of the Corporation. The act of a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is in attendance shall constitute the act of the Board of Directors, unless the act of a greater number is required by law.

Section 6. Conduct of Business. At the meetings of the Board of Directors, matters pertaining to the purposes of the Corporation shall be considered in such order as from time to time the Board of Directors may determine.

At all meetings of the Board of Difectors, the president shall preside, and in the absence of the president, the vice president shall exercise the powers of the president.

The secretary of the Corporation shall act as secretary of all meetings of the Board of Directors, but in the absence of the secretary, the presiding officer may appoint any person to act as secretary of the meeting.

Section 7. Executive Committee. The Board of Directors, by resolution passed by a majority of the directors in office, may designate two or more directors to constitute an executive committee, which committee, to the extent provided in such resolution, shall have and may exercise all of the authority of the Board of Directors in the management

of the Corporation, except where action of the Board of Directors is specified by law. The executive committee shall act in the manner provided in such resolution. The executive committee so designated shall keep regular minutes of the transactions of its meetings and shall cause such minutes to be recorded in books kept for that purpose in the office of the Corporation, and shall report the same to the Board of Directors from time to time.

Section 8. Compensation of Directors. Directors as such shall not receive any salary or compensation for their services, except that they shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties hereunder.

ARTICLE III

OFFICERS

Section 1. Titles and Term of Office. The officers of the Corporation shall be chosen by the Board of Directors. The officers shall be a president and a vice president, who shall be members of the Board of Directors, and a secretary and a treasurer, who may or may not be members of the Board of Directors, and such other officers who may or may not be members of the Board of Directors, as the Board of Directors may from time to time elect or appoint. The Board of Directors shall elect or appoint such officers at its first meeting and at the first meeting of fiscal year in each alternate year thereafter. One person may hold more than one office, except that the president shall not hold the office of secretary. Officers of the Corporation shall serve for a term of two years or until their successors are chosen and qualified in their stead.

All officers shall be subject to removal from office, with or without cause, at any time by a vote of a majority of the entire Board of Directors.

A vacancy in the office of any officer shall be filled by a vote of a majority of the directors.

Section 2. Powers and Duties of the President. The president shall be the chief executive officer of the Corporation and, subject to the Board of Directors, he shall be in general charge of the properties and affairs of the Corporation; he shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors; in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation, he may sign and execute all contracts, conveyances,

franchises, bonds, deeds, assignments, mortgages, notes and other instruments in the name of the Corporation.

Section 3. Vice President. The vice president shall have such powers and duties as may be assigned to him by the Board of Directors and shall exercise the powers of the president during that officer's absence or inability to act. Any action taken by the vice president in the performance of the duties of the president shall be conclusive evidence of the absence or inability to act of the president at the time such action was taken.

Section 4. Treasurer. The treasurer shall have custody of all the funds and securities of the Corporation which come into his hands. When necessary or proper, he may endorse, on behalf of the Corporation, for collection, checks, notes and other obligations and shall deposit the same to the credit of the Corporation in such bank or banks or depositories as shall be designated in the manner prescribed by the Board of Directors; he may sign all receipts and vouchers for payment made to the Corporation, either alone or jointly with such other officer as is designated by the Board of Directors; whenever required by the Board of Directors, he shall render a statement of his cash account; he shall enter or cause to be entered regularly in the books of the Corporation to be kept by him for that purpose full and accurate accounts of all monies received and paid out on account of the Corporation; he shall perform all acts incident to the position of treasurer subject to the control of the Board of Directors; he shall, if required by the Board of Directors, give such bond for the faithful discharge of his duties in such form as the Board of Directors may require.

Section 5. Secretary. The secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors in books provided for that purpose; he shall attend to the giving and serving of all notices; in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation, he may sign with the president in the name of the Corporation, and/or attest the signature thereto, all contracts, conveyances, franchises, bonds, deeds, assignments, mortgages, notes and other instruments of the Corporation; he shall have charge of the corporate books, records, documents and instruments, except the books of account and financial records and securities of which the treasurer shall have custody and charge, and such other books and papers as the Board of Directors may direct, all of which shall at all reasonable times be open to inspection upon application at the office of the Corporation during business hours, and he shall in general perform all duties

incident to the office of secretary subject to the control of the Board of Directors.

Section 6. Compensation. Officers as such shall not receive any salary or compensation for their services, except that they shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses incurred in the performance of their duties hereunder.

ARTICLE IV

PROVISIONS RECARDING ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND BYLAWS

Section 1. Effective Date. These Bylaws shall become effective only upon the occurrence of the following events:

(1) the approval of these Bylaws by the Governing Body; and

(2) the adoption of these Bylaws by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Amendments to Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws. The Articles of Incorporation may at any time and from time to time be amended, provided that the Board of Directors files with the Governing Body a written application requesting that the Governing Body approve such amendment to the Articles of Incorporation, specifying in such application the amendment or amendments proposed to be made. If the Governing Body by appropriate resolution finds and determines that it is advisable that the proposed amendment be made, authorizes the same to be made and approves the form of the proposed amendment, the Board of Directors shall proceed to amend the Articles as provided in the Act.

The Articles of Incorporation may also be amended at any time by the Governing Body at its sole discretion by adopting an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation by resolution of the Governing Body and delivering the Articles of Amendment to the Secretary of State as provided in the Act.

These Bylaws may be amended by majority vote of the Board of Directors with the written approval of the Governing Body as provided above. The Bylaws may also be amended by the Governing Body as provided above.

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Section 3. Interpretation of Bylaws. These Bylaws and all the terms and provisions hereof shall be liberally construed to effectuate the purposes set forth herein. If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or other part of these Bylaws, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall ever be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of these Bylaws and the application of such word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or other part of these Bylaws to any other person or circumstance shall not be affected thereby.

ARTICLE V

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 1. Principal Office. The principal office of the Corporation shall be located in Colorado County, Texas.

The Corporation shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Texas (the "State") a registered office, and a registered agent whose business office is identical with such registered office, as required by the Act. The registered office may be, but need not be, identical with the principal office in the State, and the address of the registered office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors, pursuant to the requirements of the Act.

Section 2. Fiscal Year. The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be as determined by the Board of Directors.

Section 3. Seal. The seal of the Corporation shall be as determined by the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Notice and Waiver of Notice. Whenever any notice whatsoever is required to be given under the provisions of the Act, the Articles of Incorporation or these Bylaws, said notice shall be deemed to be sufficient if given by depositing the same in a post office box in a sealed postpaid wrapper addressed to the person entitled thereto at his post office address, as it appears on the books of the Corporation, and such notice shall be deemed to have been given on the day of such mailing. Attendance of a director at a meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a director attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business on the grounds that the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted

at nor the purpose of any Regular or Special Meeting of the Board of Directors need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting, unless required by the Board of Directors. A waiver of notice in writing, signed by the person or persons entitled to said notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

Section 5. Resignations. Any director or officer may resign at any time. Such resignation shall be made in writing and shall take effect at the time specified therein, or, if no time be specified, at the time of its receipt by the president or secretary. The acceptance of a resignation shall not be necessary to make it effective, unless expressly so provided in the resignation.

Section 6. Action Witbout a Meeting of Directors or Committees. Any action which may be taken at a meeting of the Board of Directors or of any committee may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing, setting forth the action to be taken, shall be signed by all of the directors, or all of the members of the committee, as the case may be. Such consent shall have the same force and effect as a unanimous vote and may be stated as such in any articles or document filed with the Secretary of State, the Texas Industrial Commission or any other person.

Section 7. Approval or Advice and Consent of the Governing Body. To the extent that these Bylaws refer to any approval by the County or refer to advice and consent by the County, such advice and consent shall be evidenced by a certified copy of a resolution, order or motion duly adopted by the Governing Body.

Section 8. Organizational Control: The County may, at its sole discretion, and at any time, alter or change the structure, organization, programs or activities of the Corporation (including the power to terminate the Corporation), subject to any limitation on the impairment of contracts entered into by such Corporation.

Section 9. Dissolution of the Corporation. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, title to or other interests in any real or personal property owned by the Corporation at such time shall vest in the County.
