**ORDER RESCINDING DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER  
FOR COLORADO COUNTY, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2022, Colorado County Judge Ty Prause issued a Declaration of Local Disaster for the unincorporated areas of Colorado County due to the severe drought conditions and the threat of dangerous and fast moving wildfires; and

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2022, the Colorado County Commissioners Court renewed and extended the Declaration of Local Disaster; and

WHEREAS, due to recent weather conditions, rainfall and a slight temporary cooling weather pattern, the conditions no longer constitute an imminent threat of disaster.

NOW THEREFORE, UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 418.108, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

The Declaration of Local Disaster declared by Colorado County Judge, Ty Prause on July 21, 2022 and renewed and extended by Colorado County Commissioners Court on July 25, 2022 is hereby **RESCINDED** due to recent weather conditions, rainfall and a slight temporary cooling weather pattern.
