RESOLUTION NO. 2026-01-14

**A RESOLUTION CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION
TO BE HELD ON MAY 2, 2026 THE STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF COLORADO §CITY OF WEIMAR §**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Weimar, Texas (the “City”), is authorized under the Texas Election Code to call and conduct a general election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that a general election should be held on **Saturday, May 2, 2026**, a uniform election date authorized by Texas law, for the purpose of electing municipal officers: Mayor, Council Members, Place 2 and Place 4 and/or submitting any authorized propositions to the qualified voters of the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to **Section 31.092 and Section 31.100 of the Texas Election Code**, the City has entered into an **Election Services Contract** with the **Colorado County Elections Administrator**, Rebecka LaCourse, to conduct and supervise the election; and

WHEREAS, the Election Services Contract provides that Colorado County will arrange for polling places, conduct Early Voting and Election Day voting, provide election judges and clerks, supply voting equipment, tabulate results, and perform all other services required for the proper conduct of the election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEIMAR, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. CALLING OF ELECTION

A general election is hereby called and ordered to be held by the City of Weimar, Texas, on **Saturday, May 2, 2026**, for the purpose of electing municipal officers: Mayor, Council Members, Place 2 and Place 4 and/or submitting propositions as authorized by law.

SECTION 2. ELECTION DAY HOURS AND LOCATIONS

Election Day voting shall be conducted on **May 2, 2026**, from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** at polling places designated by the Colorado County Elections Administrator and authorized by the City Council, in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 3. EARLY VOTING

Early Voting by personal appearance and by mail shall be conducted on dates, during times, and at locations established by the Colorado County Elections Administrator, as provided by Texas law.

SECTION 4. ELECTION SERVICES

The City Council hereby ratifies and confirms the **Election Services Contract** between the City of Weimar and Colorado County. Colorado County, acting through the County Elections Administrator, is authorized to conduct and supervise all aspects of the election, including but not limited to:

- Procuring and distributing ballots, supplies, and equipment
- Preparing electronic pollbooks
- Supervising Early Voting and Election Day voting
- Training, appointing, and compensating election judges and clerks
- Operating the Central Counting Station and tabulating election results
- Preparing unofficial and official canvass materials
- Retaining and lawfully destroying election records

SECTION 5. ELECTION OFFICIALS

Election judges, alternate judges, clerks, Early Voting Ballot Board members, and Central Counting Station personnel shall be appointed and provided by Colorado County in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 6. VOTING EQUIPMENT

Voting equipment used in the election shall be furnished by Colorado County. Equipment costs shall be assessed to the City in accordance with the Election Services Contract, including costs for ExpressVote ADA units and DS200 optical scanners.

SECTION 7. NOTICE OF ELECTION

The City Secretary is authorized and directed to provide notice of the election as required by law, including publication in a newspaper of general circulation, posting on the City's website, and any other notice required under the Texas Election Code.

SECTION 8. COSTS OF ELECTION


The City shall pay Colorado County the actual costs incurred in conducting the election, including a ten percent (10%) administrative fee, pursuant to **Texas Election Code §31.100** and the Election Services Contract.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
